TEACHER TRAINING WORKSHOP First Semester 2023



1st semester 2023

May 10th we held an open training session at Aguas de Ramón Nature Park, where 24 people participated. Teachers, outdoor guides, professionals who work with different municipalities and civic organizations.

In this introductory session of 8 hours, we provided various tools and strategies to be used for environmental education.

This day had a cost of \$32,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD 34 per person for general public, \$10,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD 10 per person for outdoor guides and was free for those who were unable to pay. A total of \$382,000 Chilean pesos was raised, approximately \$USD 400 which was used for the purchase of materials and catering service.

1st semester 2023

During the month of May we participated as exhibitors in the CIEDS, International Congress of Education for Sustainable Development, in the Araucanía Region. This was a three-hour event with 34 participated, including teachers, teacher trainees and professionals from various organizations.

2nd Semester 2023

During the month of July, we carried out another open training session titled Outdoor Education and Introduction to “Project Learning Tree” in Aguas de Ramón Nature Park with 27 participated. The session lasted 7 hours and we were able to teach various PLT activities for students from PreK through 8th Grade. Because of the economic crisis Chile through, the cost of the session was reduced to \$12,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD 12 per person for teachers, \$10,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD 10 per person for outdoor guides and \$7,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD7 per person for trainee teachers. This event allowed us to raise a total of \$215,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD 230 which was used to cover the costs of the training itself.



2nd Semester 2023

On October 20th, we held an in-depth training session at Parque Cantalao, Peñalolén, Santiago. 14 teachers participated; all had taken part in the introductory training to PLT during the first semester. This session lasted 6 hours and participants worked on their teaching plans, linking this to PLT and the national curriculum. The cost of this training was \$12,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD 12 per person for teachers, \$7,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD 7 per person for trainee teachers and zero cost for those who required it. It was possible to raise a total of \$70,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD 75 which was used to cover the costs of the day.

2nd Semester 2023

On November 27th, we held a free training session in the city of Villarica Araucania Region of Chile, where 25 teachers from different schools in the Loncoche Community participated. This lasted 3 hours and the participants were able to experience various PLT activities to take back to their classrooms.

2nd Semester 2023

On November 27th, in addition to the training carried out in Villarrica, we ran an activity at the Egon Keutmann School in Huiscaqui, where we organized a PLT activity for group of 10 students.

2nd Semester 2023

On December 11th, we trained 7 monitors who had signed up for the Summer Activity Program at the Lo Barnechea Cultural Center. We trained this group for 4 hours on specific PLT activities so they could use them during the summer program. These monitors acquired various tools to apply with the 200 children whom participated.





2nd Semester 2023

On December 12th we took part in the Explora Va Camp! Natural Laboratories and Citizen Science. 44 teachers from various municipal schools in the Metropolitan Region were able to live the PLT experience and acquire new tools to take to their schools.

This event was held free of cost in the location of Cuncumen, an hour east from Santiago. It lasted approximately 3 hours.



2nd Semester 2023

On December 13th, we held a PLT introductory training session at the Sagrado Corazón of Apoquindo School, where 29 teachers from First Grade to Sixth Grade took part.

They were able to acquire new teaching skills to assist in providing PLT.

This training session had a cost of \$15,000 Chilean pesos, approximately USD\$ 16 per teacher and were able to raise \$450,000 Chilean pesos, approximately \$USD 481 which was used to cover expenses associated with the training.

2nd Semester 2023

On December 27th, we carried out a PLT training session for 19 teachers from the Raihue Montessori Pre-School.

This training lasted 4 hours and cost \$10,000 Chilean pesos per person, approximately \$USD10 raising a total of \$190,000 Chilean pesos, approximately USD\$ 203, which was used to finance the training session.
